

Email has been sent to parents in relation to the issue that we have with our polo shirts.

Ongoing issues with Lowes (Beare & Ley) with ordering of our school long sleeve and short sleeve polo shirts. Placed an order with the supplier on the 5th May 2017 order was received but still no delivery. I have emailed numerous times at least once a week to check if there is an update same answer given will check with production. I feel that this is unacceptable turn around and if they are not going to supply the requested stock we have no option but to look elsewhere for a supplier who can meet our demands for stock. I am not sure how I can do anymore in regard to this as I am out of stock in the smaller sizes and starting to run low in other sizes.

I have requested a sample from one of our other suppliers for a look at their polo's Spartan have come back with a sample shirt like our Zip Bomber Jacket with the stripes in Gold with a Royal strip and a Royal with a Gold Stripe. As from information obtained from last year's survey in relation to the White sports shirts I personally think that the Royal with the Gold Stripes is a good replacement and the price on these shirts at the moment is very affordable and cheaper than what we are currently paying. Price including GST is \$8.80 embroidery would be an extra \$3.50 so total cost per unit would be approximately \$12.30 with a mark-up would recommend selling the shirts at \$15 for 2 months. The Gold polos are also \$8.80 again could look at selling these at a reduced price for 3 months for about \$12.

There is a limited stock availability on these shirts as they are in clearance but even as a custom make they would be a viable option to our current shirts.
